Our Business and Structure

Our Policies

Due Diligence and Risk Assessment

We conduct risk assessments to identify areas of our business and supply chains where modern slavery risks may arise. Our due diligence processes include supplier audits, contract terms that prohibit modern slavery, and whistleblowing mechanisms.

Measuring Effectiveness

We measure our effectiveness in combatting modern slavery through KPI: audit results, supplier compliance rates, employee training completion. We continuously review our policies to improve our processes.

Training

We provide modern slavery awareness training to our employees and key supply chain partners to ensure they understand the risks and how to report concerns.
